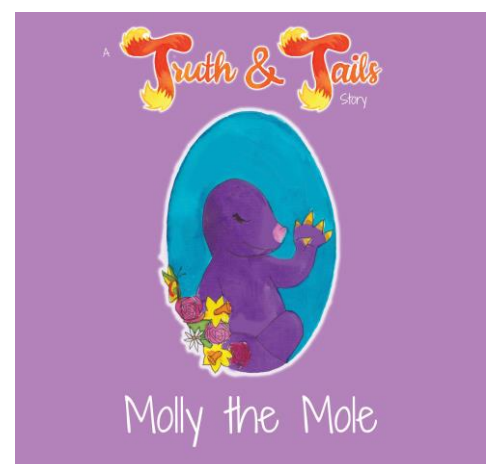
Who are Truth + Tails?
